Domestic Appliance Safety Testing

Chris Cole is qualified to carry out Portable Appliance Testing and does this for all electrical equipment sold in Discoveries. If you have any portable electric appliances at home that you would like to be safety tested, he would be delighted to carry it out in exchange for a donation to the Church Building Fund. The cost is a minimum of £5 for two items plus £1 each for any additional items. The cost includes a visual inspection, tightening up connections and replacing unsuitable fuses. This is followed by an electrical earth and insulation test. If an item fails the test, then unfortunately the service does not include any fault finding and repair. If you are
